### Subject of the Grievance

This case concerns an alleged Title 212 bypass of a Lineman who was not called in to work following the conclusion of a rest period.

### Facts of the Case

On December 12, 1987, a storm occurred in the Santa Cruz area. On December 15, 1987, the grievant reported for work at his regular starting time of 7:00 a.m. and worked until 6:30 a.m. on December 16, 1987 when he went on a rest period. On the morning of the 16th, San Jose Division sent crews to Santa Cruz, some of which worked until 5:30 a.m. on December 17. The grievant believed that he should have been called out at the conclusion of his rest period. To the best of the grievant's recollection, he was sent home on the morning of December 16. The General Foreman stated that the grievant elected to go home.

### Decision

The Committee agreed that the evidence indicates that the grievant requested to go home the morning of December 16. This, coupled with the fact that the assignment of the San Jose crews to Santa Cruz was made during regular work hours negated any Arbitration Case No. 120 arguments the grievant may make about being allowed to continue working. Further, since there were no callouts made upon the conclusion of the grievant's rest period, there was no violation of Title 212. This case is closed without adjustment and should be so noted by the Local Investigating Committee.
