The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Pre-Review Committee and is being returned to the Local Investigating Committee with a recommendation for settlement in accordance with the following guidelines.

In brief, the Committee recognized that input of regulator data input forms and filing of completed service tags may be done by either the Gas Service Department or by clerical employees, depending on operational needs in a given location. The Committee believes that in this case it is appropriate, given more frequent use by the Customer Services Department, to leave the filing of tags in the Customer Services Department at this headquarters.

For GSEM work, there is no compelling reason to move the work from the Service Operators who have historically performed that work. Therefore, this work should remain with the Service Operators in the Gas Service Department.

Pre-Review Committee Case No. 1291 is closed. This settlement is not intended to be applicable to any other headquarters.
