Grievance Issue: Improper rate of pay for MEOBs working as Truck Drivers.

Discussion:

The Union argued that the Company should adjust the wage rate of the MEOB classification to a wage higher than that of a Truck Driver. This would then keep the historical relationship between the classifications and the intent of the lines of progression. Company argued that this issue should be resolved through bargaining and not through the grievance procedure.

The Committee noted that in those instances where an employee is regularly assigned to operate a five-yard dump, they are being classified and compensated as Light Truck Driver. The Committee agreed that to do otherwise would be inappropriate.

Decision:

This case is closed without adjustment.
