### CASE SUBJECT:

RECEIVED OCT 2 2 1990

This case concerns the bypass of an Electrician in the Hydro Department to an Electric Maintenance Crew Foreman position located at the Helms Powerhouse. The reason for the bypass was the Electricians alleged refusal to meet the Helms residency requirement.

## CASE FACTS:

- 1. The grievant is the senior, qualified "B" bidder to the Electric Maintenance Crew Foreman position at Helms. There are no "A" bidders to the position.
- 2. The position was filled by a more junior, qualified bidder on February 5,1990.
- 3. The grievant stated that he would maintain a residence at Helms but could not commit his wife and family to living at Helms. His wife and family live in Shaver Lake which is 45 minutes to one hour from the headquarters, depending on road conditions.

#### DISCUSSION:

The Committee discussed the intent of the residency requirement at Helms in great length. The Company opinioned that the grievant's statement in #3 above gave the Company no indication of a commitment to be readily (i.e. travel time from the adjacent housing) available after normal working hours should a plant emergency arise.

The Committee agreed that the Company's opinion as stated above is an assumption and not a valid reason for bypass.

#### SETTLEMENT:

The Committee agreed to place the grievant into the Electric Maintenance Crew Foreman position at Helms with compensation retroactive to February 5,1990.

This case is closed based on the above.
