Subject of the Grievance:

The Company allegedly used a contract backhoe while Company equipment sat idle.

Facts of the Case:

The Company used a contract backhoe and operator from April 8, 1991 through April 24, 1991. The Area Foreman stated that Company backhoe may have been idle for up to six days during the period the contractor worked.

Discussion:

The Company argued that the contractor was working before the equipment became idle; that the idle backhoe was in the process of being shipped to a new headquarters where the operator was transferred.

The Union argued that the senior qualified employee should have been upgraded to operate the idle backhoe and that the contractor was not necessary during the time the backhoe sat idle.

Decision:

Company agreed based on the facts in this case to pay the senior qualified employee in the promotion/demotion area five days of upgrade to Backhoe Operator. This case is closed without prejudice to the parties.
