PRE-REVIEW REFERRAL

North Valley Division Grievance No. CHI-93-55 Pre-Review Committee File No. 1760

Subject of the Grievance:

This grievance concerns the appropriateness of assigning work located in the Red Bluff service territory to a Senior Meterman, headquartered in Chico.

Facts of the Case:

Due to a temporary shortage of manpower in the Red Bluff Meter Department, employees from the Chico Meter Department were being routinely assigned work in the Red Bluff area.

On November 30, 1993, a Chico Senior Meterman had reported to Red Bluff to assist a Senior Meterman perform work in Burney. The Senior Meterman's normal work hours were from 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., however, due to the travel time involved, he worked from 6:00 a.m. to 5:45 p.m. A Red Bluff Senior Meterman grieved, believing that the overtime worked by the Chico Senior Meterman could not be equalized.

Discussion:

The Committee noted that the Senior Meterman temporarily assigned to Red Bluff only accumulated overtime as a result of the commuting distance he was required to travel. Therefore, the Committee concluded that there was no contractual violation in the assignment of prearranged overtime.

Decision:

This case is closed without adjustment and such closure should be noted by the Local Investigating Committee.
