DECISION
LETTER DECISION
PRE-REVIEW REFERRAL

Diablo Division Grievance No. CON-94-32 PRC 1833

Subject of the Grievance:

This case concerns the utilization of an Operating Clerk in the Transmission Department at Meadow Lane Substation.

Facts of the Case:

In 1990 a transmission crew was established at Meadow Lane Substation. A Field Clerk position was also established as it could be utilized in the office and on the crew. However, the Field Clerk was utilized all of the time in the office. In 1994, the Field Clerk was displaced and an Operating Clerk-Typist position was created.

Discussion:

Company opined that it was inappropriate to use the Field Clerk solely in the office as was decided in PRC Case Nos. 1361 and 1362 and that Operating Clerk positions had historically supported Substation operations.

The Union opined that the classifications comprising the transmission crew: Electric Crew Foreman, Linemen, and Equipment Operator had historically received clerical support from either Foreman's Clerk or Field Clerk, both physical bargaining unit classifications.

The Committee reviewed Letter Agreement 90-69 which established the transmission crews and noted that Item 3 states: "Crews will work under the direction of Region Transmission and Substation Department supervision" and that the Meadow Lane Substation was identified as a headquarters for one of the transmission crews.

Prior to 1990 there was no Transmission Department within the context of the bargained agreement.

Decision:

Based on the historical utilization of Operating Clerks to support the Substation Department and that Operating Clerks are being utilized in all locations where transmission crews are headquartered, the Pre-Review Committee agrees to close this case without adjustment.
