At issue in this case is the utilization of a Water Department crew, consisting of a Water Systems Repairman and a Utility Worker, to install ladder racks in Poe Powerhouse. The job took 2-3 days. This case is similar to and is settled on the same basis as another recently settled case, PRC 1797.

That decision states:

"The Committee agrees that the work in question is more appropriately assigned to Hydro Maintenance Department employees inasmuch as it was inside the powerhouse, the work was to the structure itself, and the Water Department crew worked without the assistance of hydro maintenance employees."

"The Committee notes however, that there is a historic practice of allowing Water Department employees to perform some work within hydro powerhouses and that this should be clarified to avoid similar disputes in the future. The Committee recommends that this may be an appropriate subject to be addressed by the Hydro L/A 94-53 Committee."
