This case concerns the displacement of the grievant from a Groundman position in Marysville pursuant to the provisions of Title 206. The grievant was discharged October 30, 1992 and reinstated through Arbitration Decision 200 on January 9, 1995. In 1993, during the period that the grievant was off, the company declared a lack of work system-wide for a number of classifications, including Groundman. The incumbent employees were given options pursuant to Title 206. In February 1995, with the first round of displacements following the grievant's reinstatement, he also was given displacement options.

The agreed upon clarification of Title 206, Demotion and Layoff Procedure, provides that employees who would otherwise be impacted by a displacement proceeding but are off the active payroll will be given their options upon return to the active payroll.

The Pre-Review Committee is in agreement that no violation of the contract occurred. This case is closed without adjustment.
