Subject of the Grievance

This case concerns a Decision Making Leave given to an employee for carrying an ineligible dependent on his medical plan in excess of 10 years. The grievant agreed to reimburse the Company for premium equivalents.

Facts of the Case

The grievant divorced in 1986. In October of 1997 he contacted the Benefits department to request his personal identification number (PIN). During a verification of personal information, it was discovered that the grievant had his ex-wife on the medical plan. The grievant alleged that he notified the Human Resources Department in 1986 to remove his ex-wife from the plan.

Decision

The Committee agreed that the grievant was negligent in not removing his ex-wife from the plan, especially given the fact that he had received numerous Company mailings over the years that listed her on the plan. The Committee agreed that given the considerable length of time that the grievant had an ineligible dependent on the plan the DML was appropriate.

On that basis, this grievance is considered closed.
