Subject of the Grievance

This case concerns distribution of prearranged overtime at the Topock Gas Transmission headquarters for 1998.

Facts of the Case

This grievance concerns the prearranged overtime worked by two classifications: Gas Control Technician (2) and Transmission Mechanic (7).

In the Transmission Mechanic classification, the disparity in hours was caused by the assignment of two of the employees to a special project entering information about the department's equipment and assets into a database. Continuity of work was the driving factor in not rotating this assignment. Additionally, using the PRC 1456 formula, the perarranged overtime in this classification at this headquarters, was equitable.

As to the Gas Control Technicians, the supervisor recalled that no one in that classification had denied an overtime assignment, however, no records were kept as to refused assignments. The reconciliation of the records and the application of the formula in PRC 1456 indicates the Gas Control Technician overtime was equitable.

In August 1998 and at various other times, management was questioned about the overtime accumulation and distribution. At the end of 1998 a local administrative agreement was executed for the distribution of prearranged overtime.
