Dear Sir:

In accordance with the discussions of the Review Committee at its July 14th meeting relative to Review Committee file No. 24, the Union wishes to withdraw this case without prejudice to our position. Due to the clouded record and the misunderstandings presented by this case, we feel no purpose would be served by carrying it further.

We wish to state, however, for the future dispensation of cases of similar nature that only those people complying with the enclosed Union bulletin, which was issued 4-21-53, will be eligible to terminate membership under Title 4, Section 4.1 of the Agreement. No member of Local Union 1245 has authority to accept resignations or terminations except where this procedure has been followed.

Upon receipt of acknowledgment of this letter, we will consider Review Committee file No. 24 to be closed.
