On January 31, 1956 you referred to Review, Grievance no. 59 - Alleged Short Change, Fleming, Volta Power House.

This grievance was discussed in Review Committee meetings of February and march of this year. At the February meeting the Union produced a working schedule which indicated Fleming was scheduled in advance to report at Inkship Power House on June 13, 1955, rather than at Volta, as indicated in the statement of facts of Grievance No. 59.

Inasmuch as later, after a telephone call from me, you verified the existence of such schedule and could not account for any change, it was agreed in Review that the employee's work at Volta on June 13, 1955 must have been performed under emergency relief conditions. He is, therefore, entitled to overtime compensation for work performed in the 12 hour period following the end of his last preceding work period on June 12, 1955.

Please authorize such payment and state the settlement of the grievance in your Joint Grievance Committee minutes.
