

REVIEW COMMITTEE DECISION

R. C. File No. 137

General Construction Department Grievance No. 245

SUBJECT OF GRIEVANCE:

Employees in the Station Division were instructed to report for work at 8:00 a.m. at Pittsburg Power Plant and to terminate their day's work at 4:30 p.m. at the same location. Previously such employees had been reporting for work at a "point of assembly" established at a location in the City of Pittsburg and travel time was allowed to and from the work site at Pittsburg Power Plant. Union claimed the change in procedure was in violation of Section 302.10 and requested the Division to re-establish the "point of assembly." The Department argued that Pittsburg Power Plant is at the City limits of Pittsburg and that the ordered change in the report location did not result in a contract violation.

STATEMENT AND DECISION:

Section 302.10 reads in part as follows: "When regular employees are engaged in work . . . . a point of assembly shall be designated for each job . . . . and the time spent by such employees in traveling between such points of assembly and work sites shall be considered as time worked, provided, however, that the foregoing shall not apply when any such job is in a town or metropolitan area."

Pittsburg Power Plant being directly adjacent to the City limits of Pittsburg, this Committee has decided that in the instant case there was no violation of Section 302.10. This grievance is not upheld.
