

REVIEW COMMITTEE DECISION

Review Committee File Number 247
East Bay Division Grievance Number 168

Discussion of the Grievance

The failure of the East Bay Division Joint Grievance Committee to agree to the application of the decision reached in Review Committee Case Number 205 resulted in the present grievance. Essentially, the former decision established that the scheduling of Mr. Bevins, a Communication Technician headquartered in Oakland, to hours of work other than his regular schedule, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., without first complying with the provisions of Section 202.16, was in violation of the Agreement.

Although the Company and Union members of the Division Joint Grievance Committee agreed as to the days involved, (130 days between September 28, 1959, and April 11, 1960) they were unable to reach agreement as to the amount owing Mr. Bevins.

Decision

It is the decision of the Review Committee that the employee shall receive compensation at the overtime rate for one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) hours travel time from the employee's home to his headquarters on each of the agreed to days. In addition, he shall receive the difference between his straight time compensation, and the applicable overtime rate, for the time worked between 7:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., on each of 130 days so worked by the employee between September 28, 1959 and April 11, 1960.
