## Facts of the Grievance

The employee concerned in this grievance reported for overtime work at 7:00 a.m. on January 17, 1961. The emergency overtime work occurred on the employee's non-workday and continued until 3:00 p.m. that day. During the course of the work the employee became entitled to and was reimbursed for a meal after he had completed four hours' work. Following his release from the emergency work at 3:00 p.m., the employee contended that as he had worked four hours at the overtime rate following his last meal, he thereby became entitled to a second meal at the time he was released.

## Discussion

A question of regular work hours is involved in this grievance. Since this subject is being discussed between Company and Union, it will not be given consideration here.

## Decision

Under the facts of this case, the Review Committee's decision is that the employee was entitled to only one meal.
