The East Bay Division Joint Grievance Committee has agreed without prejudice upon the following settlement for the subject grievance:

David W. Stacy's classification seniority as an Apprentice Fitter will commence July 23, 1961 at such time when he attains the top rate of pay of that classification. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the provisions of Sections 106.2 and 106.5 will be applicable in determining Stacy's classification seniority as Apprentice Fitter.

This Committee further agrees that the provisions of the foregoing settlement shall not be disputed under the provisions of Title 102 by the following employees who were promoted to Apprentice Fitter and Clerk Driver vacancies in East Bay Division from July 24, 1961 to February 12, 1962.
