Dear Mr. Thompson:

Our current file of Review cases include a case (#344, North Bay Grievance #4-31) which raises the question of the rights of the grievant to fill a temporary vacancy in the classification of Serviceman. The correction being sought is for this grievant to be given future Serviceman vacancies in accordance with the provisions of Section 205.3.

Our review of events occurring subsequent to the filing of this grievance shows that the grievance has been the successful bidder to an Apprentice Fitter vacancy in the month of December, 1961, which changes his preferential rights to consideration under Section 205.3 to temporary vacancies in a Serviceman classification.

Inasmuch as the correction sought is no longer applicable to this grievant due to this change in status, the Union is withdrawing the case from the Review file. While this settles the case as it relates to the correction asked for we are not in agreement with the Company's basis for denial of the upgrade which led to the filing of this grievance and we still consider this issue unsettle. We are willing, as was stated in our Review meeting on March 13, 1962, to accept your suggestions that we discuss this issue as part of the total review of the entrance requirements to the classification of Serviceman.
