Dear Mr. Brown:

Reference is made to Review Case #349 (East Bay Division Grievance #210). The Head Meter Reader rate is based in part on the number of Meter Readers which the Head Meter Reader is responsible for. In this grievance, the Meter Reader was performing only that portion of the Head Meter Reader's duties which involved the rerouting of the meter books.

In view of the fact that the complainant received a "B" Clerk's rate of pay while so engaged, and such rate exceeds the rate which can be paid the Head Meter Reader with responsibility based on a minimum number of Meter Readers, the Union is withdrawing this case and will consider the matter closed.
