

REVIEW COMMITTEE DECISION

Review Committee File No. 355
Coast Valleys Division Grievance No. 18-216

Subject of the Grievance

The grievance involves a disagreement as to the rate of pay of a Fitter who has performed arc welding on a new distribution line being constructed at the time in the Carmel Valley. At the Division level the grievant contended that the ultimate purpose to be served by the line was as a transmission line. He contends, then, that in accord with Company and Union's understanding, he is entitled to pay as a Mechanic.

Discussion

The job definition of a Fitter previously provided that he is an employee who, among other things, ". . . does welding and repair work on gas and other lines, . . ." It is now provided that such an employee may arc weld on lines constructed to convey gas at 60 psi or less. The facts submitted to the Review Committee indicate that the line in question was constructed to 500 psi standards.

Decision

To settle the foregoing dispute, application will be made to the present definition. The grievant shall be paid at the Mechanic rate of pay for the period in contention.
