On May 18, 1962, we informed you that Union had referred Review Committee File No. 338 to arbitration. As a result of recent negotiations, Union has withdrawn the case from arbitration and reinsated it in the current Review Committee agenda.

The Review Committee is herewith returning Review Committee cases numbered 338 and 361 to the Division Joint Grievance Committee for disposition in accordance with the current provisions of Title 103.

Therefore, the correction asked for by those Servicemen who were regularly scheduled to work on the holiday(s) in question, and who did work such day(s), shall be desired.

Those Servicemen who were regularly scheduled to work on the holiday(s) in questions, but who were notified by Company prior to quitting time of their work day next preceding the holiday that they would not be required to work, but who subsequent to such notice were required to work, shall in addition to their holiday pay be compensated therefor as provided in Title 208.
