Regarding R. C. #392 (General Construction Grievance #282), the joint review of this case has provided a stimulus to an increased awareness of the potential hazards involved in situations similar to that which gave rise to this grievance. It has also resulted in increased precautionary and preventative measures being adopted by field crews engaged in this type of work.

This appears to be all that could be expected under the circumstances for it is an unfortunate fact that nothing can be done to change what has already occurred. Our deliberations show that no answer for this specific case can be provided by written decision of this Committee. We therefore ask that R.C. #392 be withdrawn and we will consider the case closed.
