

Dear Mr. Mitchell:

Reference is made to your letter of August 26, 1963, and our subsequent conversation concerning Union's withdrawal of Review Committee File No. 398, San Joaquin Division Grievance No. 25-183.

As stated in our previous telephone conversation, it was our understanding that the facts of the subject grievance served as the basis for withdrawal; that is, the Warehouseman was required to drive vehicles from a temporary storage yard across the street to the yard in order that he might service the vehicles. Other qualifications referred to in your letter were not a part of this grievance. It is our understanding that should these other matters arise in the future, they may be processed through the grievance procedure and answered at that time.
