The Company and the Union recently arrived at an agreed-to disposition of several cases pending in the Review Committee which relate to hours of work. In settlement of these cases, the Union has accepted certain pay adjustments in each of the below cases based on an application of the recent clarification of Titles 202 and 208. Inasmuch as the settlement includes hours which would have been worked at the overtime rate, as well as other hours at the straight rate of pay, for convenience in computing the pay adjustments our calculations represent the hours to be paid based on each employee's straight rate of pay for the period indicated.

We would appreciate your preparing retroactive pay adjustments as indicated below for each of the individuals concerned. Please advise us as to the amount to be paid in each case:
