We recently informed you that the above-subject grievances, together with Cases Nos. 597 and 739, has been referred to arbitration. Since then, Company and Union have executed a letter of agreement resolving these cases. The cases have been reinstated on the Review Committee agenda. I am attaching copies of the letter of agreement for the Division's use in making future job assignments.

The above-subject grievances will be settled by the application of the letter of agreement to the facts of each case in the manner recently discussed with Mr. Lawson. The Division will make the retroactive pay adjustments, after which the cases will be noted in the minutes of your next committee meeting as closed. Cases Nos. 597 and 739 will be withdrawn by the Union.
