

Dear Mr. Brown:

Reference is made to Review Case #678-65-82 (San Francisco Division Grievance #2-65-9).

The Union hereby withdraws this case from the active file of the Review Committee. In so doing, the Union feels that the seriousness of this case should be pointed out to those concerned.

The grievant in this case was called into a meeting with his supervisors, at which time a discussion was held and the grievant's status as a Union Shop Steward was discussed.

The notes taken at the meeting, held September 28, 1965, by H. G. Thomas, Personnel Manager, state:

"Fisk then stated that he had had this discussion to help him (Camolli) with his responsibilities as Shop Steward."

In our opinion, this action by Mr. Fisk constitutes attempted interference with Union activity and is not within the realm of employee counseling.
