## ARBITRATION SETTLEMENT "A"

(Out of Court)

San Francisco Division Grievance No. 2-66-1 Review Committee File No. 691-66-13

Filed for Arbitration April 11, 1967

Grievant was second in line to be selected for attendance at the Apprentice Lineman Training School in Kettleman. The first man on the list refused the selection because of being given such short notice. Company claimed they called the grievant but were unable to reach him. Company had only a short time to fill the vacancy at the School and went to the third man on the list. He accepted.

Grievant claimed that if he had been selected, he would have made Provisional Lineman before the third man, over whom he had seniority.

Company claimed they owed grievant nothing as he did not perform Provisional Lineman work during the period in question.

The case was settled on June 29, 1967 "out of court". Company agreed to pay grievant for one month of the period in question at the Provisional Lineman rate. Union accepted the offer and the case was closed.
