The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Review Committee as it is affected by the recently signed Labor Agreement Interpretation on "Continuing Grievances" and letter agreement on "Crossing Bargaining Unit Lines." This grievance is being returned to the Joint Grievance Committee for further discussion and disposition in accordance with the following:

In light of the above-mentioned Labor Agreement Interpretation and letter agreement, the grievant is entitled to the top rate of Meter Reader, retroactive 30 days prior to the filing of the grievance and continuing until he reached the top rate of Meter Reader.

The Division should prepare the necessary authorization for retroactive wages equal to the top rate of Meter Reader for the period November 5, 1967 to the date he reached the top of the Meter Reader rate.

Following discussion and completion of the above, this case will be considered closed and should be so noted in the minutes of the next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
