Crew Supervision on Mount Reba Extension

The above-subject grievance was forwarded to the Review Committee on January 19, 1968 and discussed at its subsequent meetings.

Two factors indicate to the Committee that little would be accomplished by retaining the case on its agenda. First, the job has been completed and, secondly, there is little factual evidence in the record upon which the Committee may proceed.

It does appear, however, that there is a need for further discussion at the Joint Grievance Committee level to resolve the concern that prompted Union to file the grievance. It is believed that these discussions can be productive of a better understanding of the work assigned to General Construction crews in this as well as future assignments.

The case is returned to the Joint Grievance Committee for further discussion and disposition. In doing this, it is the expectation of the Review Committee that the members of the Joint Grievance Committee will expand upon this concern beyond the Union's position concerning the number of persons that may comprise a crew and that the Department will enlarge upon its conclusion that the crew supervision was adequate.
