The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Review Committee and is being returned to the Division Joint Grievance Committee for settlement on the basis of Company's understanding with the Union as to the meaning of "routine service to absorption-type air conditioning equipment."

Routine service on absorption-type air conditioning equipment is intended to be limited to lighting of pilots and adjustment of burners. The Division should take the steps necessary to pay the on-call Gas Serviceman at the overtime rate of Gas Air Conditioning Serviceman for two hours, or more, as the facts may dictate.

Following payment this grievance will be considered closed and should be so noted in the minutes of the next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
