The above-subject grievance was referred to the Review Committee July 17, 1969 and discussed on July 25 and July 29, 1969. Based on the facts, it is the decision of the Review Committee that the grievant will be reinstated under the following conditions:

1. He will be required to accept an appointment as a Clerk D in the San Francisco Division Electric, Gas, or General Services Lines of Progression at a San Francisco District headquarters. Until such time as he may be appointed to the first vacancy that occurs in any one of these departments, he may be employed as a Clerk D in any department at a San Francisco District headquarters. Such appointment shall be made pursuant to the provisions of Section 18.17 of the Clerical Agreement.
2. He will be required to report to Mr. A. F. Vial, District Manager, 375 Mission Street, at 8:00 AM, Monday, August 11, 1969, for assignment.
3. His employment record will show that he was absent without pay, as a disciplinary measure, from June 26 to August 11, 1969.
4. Any bid, or request for transfer, that he may make to any classification in a Customer Service Line of Progression, until August 11, 1970, may be rejected without recourse to the grievance procedure.
