
The above-subject grievance was discussed at the last meeting of the Review Committee. It is the Committee's decision that the grievance is sustained and the grievant should be paid accordingly.

You are hereby authorized to pay Mr. Jim Jacobsen Assistant System Dispatcher, headquartered at Electric Operations Department, General Office, the sum of \$.90 for shift premium for overtime worked on March 24, 1969. At that time, Mr. Jacobsen worked at Ignacio Substation, North Bay Division, as a First Operator. His straight time rate was \$192.00 per week.

A recent Review Committee decision ruled that Mr. Jacobsen be granted the additional pay. Please refer to Mr. L.V. Brown's letter dated December 4, 1972, to Mr. F. DeGennaro, Chairman, North Bay Division Joint Grievance Committee (copy attached). The subject was Review Committee File No. 922.

Briefly, the \$.90 represents four hours shift remium (\$.60), per Section 110.2 of the Agreement, plus \$.30 for the orbitime provision, as called for in Section 110.3 of the Agreement.
