This letter supersedes our letter on this same subject dated March 20, 1970. (The last sentence in paragraph 2 was changed to 30 months before automatic progression will take place.)

The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Review Committee and is being returned to the Division Joint Grievance Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

It is the Review Committee's opinion that regardless of the wage step to which an Apprentice Communication Technician is appointed, he must accrue at least 24 months of classification seniority as an Apprentice Communication Technician before his bids to Communication Technician will be considered under Subsection 205.7(b). Similarly, automatic progression will not take place before 30 months following appointment as an Apprentice Communication Technician even though an individual meets all other qualifications for automatic progression.

This case shall be considered closed and so noted in the minutes of the next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
