The above-subject grievances have been discussed by the Review Committee and are being returned to the Joint Grievance Committee for settlement on the following basis:

Company uses tree trimming contractor crews to patrol its transmission and distribution lines for the control of tree problems and right-of-way maintenance.

In addition, by contract, tree trimming crews are required to report immediately to the Company headquarters concerned any line conditions found that affects or may affect service continuity.

During emergency and/or storm conditions, when all Company employees are utilized, contractor employees may be used to patrol circuits to locate cause of trouble.

These cases are considered closed and should be so noted in the minutes of the next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.


