Apprentice Gas Measurementmen Performing Field
Meterman Work

The above-subject grievances have been discussed by the Review Committee and are being returned to the Division Joint Grievance Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

On the surface the grievants' appointment to Apprentice Gas Measurementman at the beginning rate of pay was in conformance with Section II-A-10 of the guidelines applicable to that classification. Factually, however, it is apparent that following their appointment they were not relieved of the primary responsibilities of their former classification - Field Meterman. Limited to this particular situation, the grievants should have retained their pay as Field Meterman until such time as they were relieved of that primary function.

Accordingly, the Division will adjust the grievants' rate of pay during the period following their assignment to the apprenticeship for the period of time that they continued to perform their former primary function as Field Meterman. For the purposes of this decision, however, the employees will accrue time in the apprenticeship for future wage progression purposes and training from the date of their appointment.

After making the adjustment this case will be considered closed and should be so noted in the minutes of the next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
