Hiring Rates for Clerical Employees

There have been several requests for a set of guidelines to be used in determining the applicable rate to be paid to newly hired clerical employees under the Clerical Agreement as amended July 1, 1967. During the negotiations, Company stated that it would apply these clerical hiring rates on the following basis:

1. An employee with less than six months' clerical job experience would be hired at the starting rate.
 - An employee with six months, but less than 12 months' clerical job experience, would be hired at the six-month rate.
 - An employee with 12 months, but less than 18 months' clerical job experience, would be hired at the one-year rate.
 - An employee with 18 months, but less than 24 months' clerical job experience, would be hired at the 18-month rate.
 - An employee with two years or more of clerical job experience would be hired at the two-year or experienced hiring rate.
2. In applying Paragraph 1 to employees hired for clerical work other than machine operation, credit should be given for any office clerical work. "Office clerical work" does not include: (a) sales work in any type of retail establishment; (b) military assignments as a company, a regimental or a staff clerk of any kind; or (c) work as a teller in a bank or savings institution.
3. In applying Paragraph 1 to employees hired for machine operation, the experience must be on the same type of machine (i.e., keypunch, comptometer, tabulating or peripheral equipment) as he is being hired to operate. Such time should include military assignments where the employee's full-time job in the military consisted of such machine operation.
