The above-subject grievance has been discussed at recent meetings of the Review Committee. We are returning the case to your Committee for further investigation and attempt to resolve the grievance locally.

As we view the dispute, the central issue revolves around the question of the grievant's job assignments while reassigned to Martin Station (Substore 62). Thus, if his work assignments were varied and instructive of the duties to be performed by a Warehouseman at that substore, the assignment would be proper. On the other hand, if, as alleged by Union, he spent 80% of his time operating a fork lift, it would not appear to this Committee to be a training assignment. If the latter is the case, the temporary assignment was improper.
