The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Review Committee and is being referred back to the Division in accordance with the following:

The Joint Statement of Facts indicates that the restrictions on the grievant for promotion to Line Subforeman were removed, and he subsequently was promoted to Line Subforeman. However, the facts do not indicate when the grievant's job performance had changed to a point where supervision considered him as a qualified bidder. For this reason, the Review Committee is of the opinion that thirty days' retroactive pay as a Line Subforeman would be an equitable basis for settlement.

This case is considered closed and should be so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
