This case is considered closed and should be so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.





During several of its last meetings the Review Committee has discussed the above-subject grievance. We are returning the case to your Committee for settlement along the following lines:

The grievance raises the question of the appropriate rate of pay of a Materials Man while operating a Cole mobile crane approximately three hours a day to load and unload poles.

In comparing notes of discussions that took place during the bargaining of June 25, 1972 revised job definition for Materials Man, it is not clear to this Committee that the particular utilization of the crane in this instance was considered. The Committee did note that certain other pieces of material handling equipment were being operated by Materials Men, and that this was proper.

In view of this lack of clear understanding with respect to the negotiations of the revised job definition, the Committee considers this case closed. It is understood that this disposition of the grievance does not prejudice either party in that the matter is properly a subject for the next Company-Union negotiations.

The disposition of this case should be noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
