Delivery of Material to Job Sites

The above-subject grievances have been discussed by the Review Committee and are being returned to the Division for settlement in accordance with the following:

It appears to the Review Committee that the primary issue in the grievances is one of intra-department jurisdiction of delivering material to job sites. The Materials Department employees claim that this type of work belongs exclusively to their department. Historically, the Operating Departments have delivered material to the field on an as-needed basis. In an attempt to resolve the grievance the Review Committee recommends the following guideline:

When non-scheduled deliveries are necessary, the Operating Foreman, depending on the situation, will either request the Materials Department or the Operating Department to make delivery to the job site. The Materials Department should be utilized when there is time, manpower, and equipment available. In any event, it is the Foreman's responsibility to make the decision based upon the urgency of the situation and the practicality and availability of personnel and equipment.

These cases are considered closed and should be so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
