The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Review Committee and is being returned to the Division for settlement in accordance with the following:

The grievance concerns the establishment of a schedule of hours for a "mobile garage" unit consisting of one Garage Subforeman and two Equipment Mechanics headquartered in Fresno, assigned to various garages throughout San Joaquin Division with hours of work from 2:00 PM through 11:00 PM, Tuesday through Friday, and from 8:00 AM through 5:00 PM on Saturday. The grievants are alleging that the supervision is in violation of Section 202.15 of the Labor Agreement in that the work performed at the time of the grievance as filed could be conveniently or practicably performed during the normal working hours and workweek of 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

Subsequent to the filing of the grievance, the "mobile garage" unit has changed its operations on several occasions, which caused the Review Committee to hold the grievance pending further discussions and additional information. Currently, the "mobile garage" unit is temporarily disbanded, and two of the three employees are working temporarily in the Merced Garage and the other temporarily assigned to the Selma Garage. In reviewing the "mobile garage" unit's work for the past three years, the records (attached) indicate that the work they performed consisted of long inspections, trailer work and general maintenance which necessiated a Saturday shift. issue in dispute is whether supervision has demonstrated that they cannot conveniently or practicably perform this work with a basic workweek other than as provided in Section 202.2 of the Agreement and hours of work other than provided for in Section 202.4 of the Agreement. Even though the "mobile garage" unit is inoperative at this time, the Review Committee is of the opinion that, in this case, the Division had demonstrated a need for a basic workweek and hours of work other than as provided for in Sections 202.2 and 202.4 of the Agreement and the scheduling of these employees, pursuant to Section 202.15 of the Agreement was proper. However, the hours of work of the basic workweek must be the same for each day in the basic workweek absent an agreement to the contrary under the provisions of Subsection 202.16(b) of the Agreement.

In view of the above, the Review Committee considers this case closed, and the closure should be so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
