The Review Committee has discussed the above-subject case and is returning it to the Division for settlement in accordance with the following:

After a thorough review of the Joint Statement of Facts, the Review Committee is of the opinion that the Foreman did attempt to contact the grievant on both occasions but was unsuccessful. In the incident of July 31, 1972, he should have attempted to reach the grievant by radio but did not. However, it appears that a three-man crew was not needed; and the overtime was properly assigned. In the August 1, 1972, incident, it appears that the Supervisor called three different times; and for some unknown reason, the line was either busy or out of service. At any rate, an effort was made to assign the grievant the overtime.

The Joint Grievance Committee should review these facts in light of Review Committee Decision Nos. 1079, 1145, 1148, 1188, 1241, 1245, 1269, 1272, and 1305 pertaining to overtime callout and reach a settlement in accordance with the guidelines established in those grievances. This case is considered closed and should be so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
