DECISION LETTER DECISION DPRE-REVIEW REFERRAL Review Committee File No. 1297-73-81 San Jose Division Grievance No. D.Gr/C 8-73-22 Wage Rate For Time Worked Driving Boom Truck

MR. F. L. NETTELL, Chairman San Jose Division Joint Grievance Committee

The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Review Committee and is being returned to the Division for settlement in accordance with the following:

After a thorough review of the Joint Statement of Facts, the Review Committee is of the opinion that the assignment of the grievant and wage rate paid to him was proper. The Job Definitions and Lines of Progression for Division Gas Departments is clear as to when a Fieldman will be upgraded to Heavy Truck Driver or Equipment Operator. In this case, the truck driven by the grievant was <u>only</u> for the purpose of transporting reels of underground cable to the job site. The truck and trailer by definition did not qualify as a heavy truck. The grievant was paid a wage rate equivalent to the beginning rate of Truck Driver in accordance with the job definition and related notes of the Fieldman classification.

This case is considered closed without adjustment and should be so noted in the minutes of your next Joint Grievance Committee meeting.
