The above-subject grievance has been discussed by the Review Committee and is being returned to the Joint Grievance Committee for settlement in accordance with the following:

The issue concerns the bypass of a Meter Reader to Auxiliary Operator, Pittsburg Power Plant, for his alleged unsatisfactory work performance. The grievant, during the time the case was being processed through the grievance procedure, removed the reasons for the bypass and, at this time, is considered qualifed for transfer and promotion. Further, it has been determined that the grievant was offered a promotion and turned it down. In view of this information, the Review Committee agrees to close the grievance without prejudice to the position of the Company or Union relative to the bypass issue.

This case is considered closed on the basis of the foregoing, and the closure should be so noted by the Local Investigating Committee.
