General Construction Grievance No. 3-373-78-24 Review Committee File No. 1474-79-16

Statement of the Case

The grievance involved here concerns a promotional bypass. The grievant, a Hydro/Substation Mechanic, was bypassed for a promotion at the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant in favor of a Hydro/Substation Electrician. The Electrician formerly held the classification of Mechanic.

The reason given for the bypass was that the General Construction management intended to combine a Mechanical Crew and an Electrical Crew into one unit supervised by a working Foreman B and reporting to a Subforeman A. At the time of the vacancy, the Mechanical Crew worked under a working Foreman B while the Subforeman A directly supervised the Electrical Crew. The Electrician was selected for appointment, inasmuch as the grievant did not have an electrical background. As it developed, the crews were not combined for some time.

Discussion

Had the combination of the two units taken place at the time of the appointment, the bypass would have been proper. The question here, however, is whether the grievant was entitled to the upgrade until such time as the combination became effective. It is the conclusion of this Committee that he was.

The remaining question then concerns the period of time during which the grievant is entitled to the higher rate of pay. In this regard, the record is less than clear and on that basis the Review Committee determines that June 5, 1978 should be the cut-off date.

The grievant is entitled to working Foreman B wages from November 28, 1977 to June 5, 1978. The Department will make a retroactive wage adjustment accordingly.
