SUBJECT OF GRIEVANCE

This case concerns two issues on the training program of an Assistant Operator at the Morro Bay Switching Center. Specifically, is the training of an Assistant Operator limited to Journeyman Operators only, or can the Operating Foreman assist in that training and secondly, what amount of switching is necessary at an unattended station before an Assistant Operator can switch at other unattended stations?

DISCUSSION AND DISPOSITION

In this particular case, the Operating Foreman assisted in the training of the Assistant Operator for approximately one hour. The Assistant Operator had written the request and then performed a bypass and clear of the Regulator No. 1 at an unattended station.

After reviewing the facts of this case, this Committee agrees that while it is part of the job of a System Operator to assist in the training of an Assistant Operator, it is not the exclusive right or duty of the Journeyman Operator. As a result, there was no contractual violation in this case.

This case is closed without adjustment.
