The Review Committee retains jurisdiction if the Local Investigating Committee is unable to resolve that issue. If the issue is resolved, the case is considered closed.

Gentlemen:

This proposal cancels and supercedes Union's proposal of July 11, 1989 on this matter.

In order to resolve Review Committee Case No. 1666-88-8 that has been referred to Ad Hoc Negotiations, Company proposes that the current classification of "1035 Utility Inspector (PIO)" be modified to "1035 Utility Inspector (Golden Gate Region only)".

The present classification and job duties were established to perform the tasks in question in the subject review case and, therefore, it is logical that this application should be extended on a permanent basis to any employee performing such work in the Electric Department. Mark and locate work perfomed by the Gas Department will be assigned to appropriate Gas Department classifications.

In addition, Company proposes that the issue of compensation be remanded to the Local Investigating Committee with the Review Committee maintaining jurisdiction.

The foregoing would resolve and close Review Committee Case No. 1666-88-8.
