Gentlemen:

The Company proposes to establish a Joint Study Committee to review the job descriptions, job titles and training for Field clerical positions and Service Center clerical positions for Title 300. The Committee will consist of a Steering Committee and Working Committee. These Committees will be comprised as follows:

Steering Committee: Four members

Two Company, one of which is appoint by the Manager of Industrial Relations Two Union, one of which is Assistant Business Manager

Working Committee: Ten members

Five management employees appointed by the Company Five employees represented by the Union appointed by the Union

The Committee will use the Continuous Improvement process to address the following issues only.

- 1. Job Descriptions
- 2. Training Guidelines
- 3. Job Titles
- Lines of Progressions as impacted by items 1, 2, and 3.

Note: The Committee is not charged with changing the Field Clerical promotion/demotion areas or rights.

The Steering Committee will meet not later than August 31, 1993 and will review the recommendations of the Working Committee not later than February 1, 1994.

By the establishment of the Joint Study Committee, it is agreed that the following grievances are closed without adjustment.
