Stockton Division Grievance No. 16-557-88-10 Review Committee File No. 1683-89-8

This case concerns a Decision Making Leave received by a Temporary Gas Serviceman for having caused an explosion and fire at a customer's home. The grievant had been a Reserve Gas Serviceman for approximately 2-1/2 years and had performed as a Serviceman virtually the entire time. He had no active discipline at the time of the incident.

The parties were in agreement that the grievant did not follow established work procedures, however, were in disagreement as to the severity of the discipline. Recognizing that the discipline has been deactivated for several months and that there was no loss of pay, the Review Committee agrees to close this case without adjustment and without prejudice to the position of the parties. Union reserves the right to bring the same argument forward on any future grievance.

This case is considered closed, and such closure should be so noted by the Local Investigating Committee.
