Company proposes that this letter agreement settle Review Committee Case No. 1742 concerning Company's continued use of contract Labor Janitors to perform plant clean-up and firewatch activities at Diablo Canyon Power Plant.

This work has been contracted out at Diablo Canyon since 1983 to employees represented by a trade union local in the San Luis Obispo area. Company and Union are in agreement that the involved work is covered by the IBEW certification with PG&E and that such functions are appropriate assignments to IBEW-represented classifications. Accordingly, Review Committee Case No. 1742 will be settled on the above understanding.

Additionally, Company proposes to continue to contract this work out in the current manner with the following provisions.

- a) Union may cancel this specific waiver by serving a thirty (30) day written notice to the Company.
- b) In the event of such cancellation, Company shall meet to negotiate an appropriate classification and work schedule to perform such work. Additionally, Company will increase the 88-104 floor number at Diablo Canyon by the number of contract workers performing non-outage work at DCPP at the time of cancellation.
